The pictures below show the fun and games that took place this year. It was great success for all in attendance.

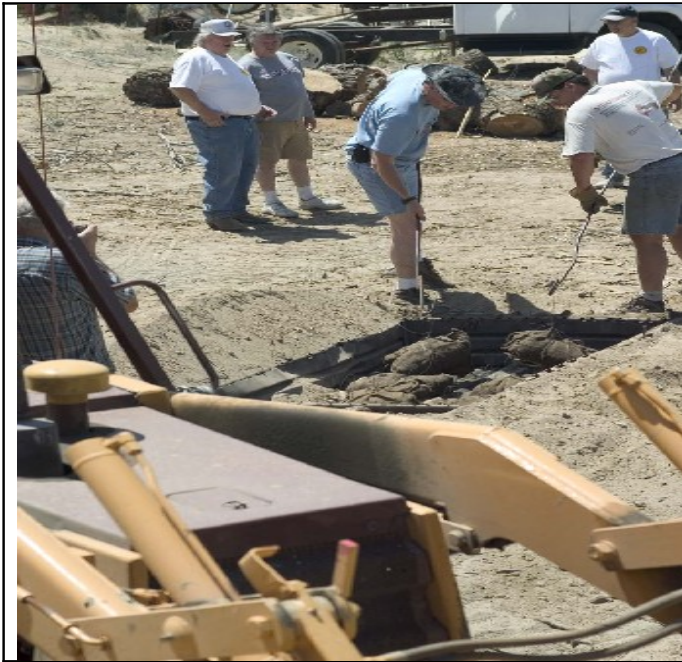
