Minutes of the July board meeting were read and approved as corrected.

Treasurers Report: Report read. Motion made by Jeff, 2nd by Rich to pay bills. Motion passed

Trap Report: Rich gave results of Palomar shoot. Escondido was the “high” club with 82.3. We were 72.4. Isaac Norfolk should get the Jr. trophy. The trap range is down because of vandalism to power lines. We will need a 4 or 5 kw generator to provide power for now

Rifle/Pistol Report: Bob Sorenson and Wayne Kline were not present. No report. Rich can run turkey shoots. There are no other rifle/pistol shoots until November.

Correspondence: Usual bulletins. There was a good safety discussion in the Lemon Grove Bulletin. Rich reported the Diane Jacob’s newsletter had an article regarding metal thefts/rural fire organizing. A \$100 deposit from Jeff’s Dutch oven group who will be using the camp facilities Nov. 7, 8 and 9. Ted had a letter from SDG&E. Also Ted and Jeff were contacted by reps. from County Planning re 2 incidents have happened at clubs resulting in lawsuits, so they are investigating clubs. Initial response – don’t think there will be any problem.

Legislature/Federation: Gun show bill defeated – which was trying to stop shows at the Cow Palace in SF. / Spay, neuter bill for dogs over 6 mos. defeated. Other bills put on hold for now.

Property: Rick not present,

Old Business: Report from trailer storage committee. 1st area proposed – south west of cabin and south of roadway. 2nd area – down the hill from the water tank. Person by person discussion so all board members could voice their concerns, this was followed then by a Vote to select an area.. Upper area (#1) was selected by a seven to five vote. A motion by Jeff, seconded by Jim that the President send letters to the owners of all trailers with registrations that are missing or out of date informing them that they have until October 6th, 2008 to bring their registrations up to date, or inform the Board as to why not. After Oct. 6th, ‘08, any trailers with out of date registrations will be moved to the designated Trailer Storage Area. Idea of motion sensor lights followed. Let’s get the area surveyed and ready – but letters need to go out with 45 day notice that indicated trailers will be moved. If we need to move trailers, we will make every effort to not damage.

Emily recommended we need an update of alternate locations for Board Meetings. Ted said he will ask at the Lakeside VFW. It was discussed of having a couple board meetings at camp to get membership participation.

New Business: Joanne requested that we remove the clause in rules and regulations, under Section 7 – Amendment #4 that states NO RESPONSE IS A POSITIVE VOTE. It will have to go out to the membership for voting. We'll follow through at the September meeting

Misc Business: Club web site now has blog going.

The next board meeting will be September 18th.

Motion made by Lonise, 2nd by Jim, to adjourn. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.

NEVER

- Climb a tree with a loaded firearm,
- Cross a fence with a loaded firearm,
- Jump a ditch or ford a stream with a loaded firearm,
- Scale or descend a steep incline or hill with a loaded firearm,
- Climb a tree, or climb into a hunting stand with a loaded firearm,
- Prop or lean a loaded firearm against a tree or other surface which may allow it to slide, or Transport a cased loaded firearm.
